BORROWING THE WPF 20 X 16 FRAMES

New charges and procedure for borrowing 20 by 16 frames

Charges will be £20 per 50 frames or part thereof. All glass breakages will be charged at 5.00 per frame. The hirer will be responsible for checking all frames at time of collection and all frames will be checked back into storage to make sure none are damaged or that any of the glass has been broken. The same checks will be applied if frames are passed on to other borrowers.

The Frame Gun will be in its own wooden box complete with gun, flexible points, screws and screwdriver. This will also be checked out and in. A replacement will be needed if it is lost.

We have 140 frames available.

Current bookings mean we only have 50 available during the first three weeks of June. There is a full 140 during September, October and November, and 80 during December and January 2012. No further bookings for 2012 yet.
